- 2.1 Wrap-up of Discussion about Late Spring schedule of Chabot College [25 Mins]
 - a. Affirmed -
 - i. “Spring” classes can’t overlap with summer session
 - ii. Classes associated with spring semester are subject to the 67% rule
 - iii. “No roll-back” was already decided for summer 2018
 - iv. Consideration of introducing some summer classes to end June 30 is a district discussion
 - b. Proposed for 2018 -
 - i. Approve for 2018 having some summer session classes end by June 30, 2018
 - ii. These classes would start after the end of the spring semester, and would be included in the summer schedule
 - iii. This would be a pilot project, subject to evaluation in August/September 2018
 - iv. The college feels this approach will allow it to meet its FTES target, otherwise it wouldn’t
 - v. The college feels this approach will not impact the regular summer 2018 FTES for 2018-2019
 - vi. Only classes ending by June 30 will be included in FTES for FY 2017-2018 (no roll-back)
 - vii. The college will be asked to provide additional information so as to track the success of this pilot
