Hi Jeannine,

Attached is the powerpoint from the meeting. Also, here is a list of colleges that have contracted for additional training that may be the farthest along to provide feedback on the experience.

In answer to your questions:

1. The 9 months starts from the beginning of implementation so in you example June.
2. The 18 months of turning off the legacy LMS is from the time the first students use Canvas.
3. I don't know of any colleges using bulk migration services from Instructure. There's quite a lot of useful documentation for conversion from Blackboard to Canvas. Faculty use the conversion opportunity to make improvements on their courses.

Steve,

Thank you for doing your presentation in our last Friday OEI meeting. Please send me a copy of your Powerpoint charts and the list of colleges migrating to Canvas. Also, there were a few items that we identified in the meeting that you also were going to send to the me to forward to our team.

By the way, I did have a few clarification questions regarding the timelines you mentioned in the meeting.

(1) You indicated that the colleges have 9 months to implement live courses for students using Canvas and the number of courses or students did not matter. Does this 9 months start from the date that we begin the Canvas implementation for the setup for our colleges that you said takes 6 weeks to 3 months or does this 9 months start after the setup for the 3 months is completed? For example, if we started the setup in June, would the 9 months start in June or when the setup was complete in August?

(2) You indicated that the colleges have 18 months to migrate off their current LMS system. Does that 18 months start AFTER the 9 months referenced in item #1 above, or does that 18 months begin from the start of the Canvas setup or the completion of the Canvas setup?

(3) We didn't have a chance to cover the topic of the conversion tool that we have heard converts 65-70% from Blackboard to Canvas. For the percentage of work remaining, did most of the colleges have faculty complete that work or did they contract with Canvas to provide contract services to assist in this work? If some colleges used services from Canvas, can you give me names of a few of the colleges who did so.
